Decades of Extreme Union-Busting: Companies have increasingly gone to extreme lengths to stop workers from organizing, spending millions on union-busting consultants and illegally firing union supporters.

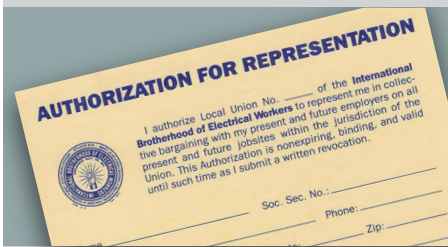


A New Wave of Organizing: In the wake of the pandemic, we've seen interest in unions and organizing campaigns skyrocket as workers stand up for themselves and fight back against mistreatment and corporate greed.

Putting Worker Allies in Key Roles: The Biden administration supported these organizers by appointing pro-worker officials to the National Labor Relations Board, which oversees most organizing campaigns. These officials have worked to address illegal union-busting.

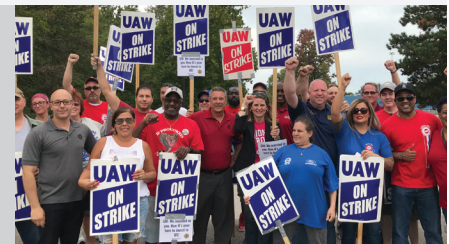

Making Organizing Easier: Not only has the administration gone after union-busters, they've declared that if an organizing campaign has a majority of signatures in favor of a union and the company commits illegal union-busting, the new union automatically will be recognized.

More to Do: It's still too easy for greedy businesses to prevent workers from exercising their rights. We must pass the Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act to fix our outdated labor laws, make organizing simpler and end anti-worker laws like "right to work."
