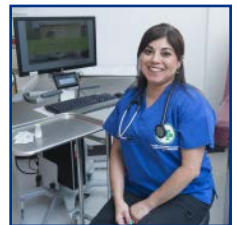

President Biden is Working with Unions to Fix Unsafe Working Conditions

TOGETHER, we have been able to strengthen health and safety protections for workers to save lives.

- Strengthening enforcement so that bad-acting employers are held accountable when they violate the law.
- Banning and phasing out asbestos and other toxic chemicals.
- Requiring employers to submit workplace injury data to OSHA to prevent hazards.
- Ensuring workers have their own representative during OSHA inspections, like employers do.
- Protecting indoor and outdoor workers from heat exposure.
- Increasing worker access to information about their job safety rights and whistleblower rights.

On this Workers Memorial Day, we grieve those we have lost due to unsafe working conditions. We must continue to fight to protect our right to good, safe jobs.
